South Asia Update

We thank God for the way He has gone before us in our work in South Asia. The school with its students in the photo featured above was started four years ago and has healthy, happy children. proudly wearing their Caleb Foundation uniforms. has established a new school recently which now makes 8 schools and over 700 students being educated. Many of these children are from poor families and they wear just the one set of clothes 24/7.

Three directors of the Caleb Foundation, Warwick, Jill and Bruce were able to visit our orphanage last month and enjoyed catching up with the boys. The little boys are being well fed and looked after beautifully. They are bright and win many of the school prizes. It's a delight for us to know we are making a difference in these children's lives. During our visit the boys performed a little role play they had rehearsed about the parable of the prodigal son.

We visited a Hindu village in the north of the country to tell stories and encourage people in this very poor area. Each year Caleb Foundation provides blankets and this district and four other districts gets very cold at Christmas. Many die with no resources to buy warm clothes or blankets.

A Uniform Matter

Our Compassion students attending school come from verv poor circumstances in slum areas. They are unable to wear uniforms for school. The Foundation is aiming to provide funds so that many of these children will have a uniform that also serves as an additional set of clothes.
