New Multi-Purpose Building Opened

A new Multi-Purpose Building in the north of the country was opened in November by local Government officials and 2 of the Caleb Directors. This building will provide a school with high quality education, initially for 100 children, in a poor rural village. It will also provide a facility for the pastor to connect with the local M... community. Over time it is planned for the school to expand and provide education up to Year 10. The construction of the building was made possible by a significant gift from one donor and we thank God for their generosity.





Four Boys at the Orphanage are now in High School

The 12 boys are coming along really well, with all in the top half of their classes. Four of the boys are now in High School. Our Chairman, Warwick Lloyd, met with the Principal of their local school which provides education from Kindergarten to Year 10 and has over 1,000 students. The Principal was very complimentary about the boys' development and as well as their behaviour! We run a Youth Program for them every Friday night lead by the Youth Pastor from the nearby city.
